Brothers and Sisters in Christ Jesus,

In my office in the rectory of Mary, Our Lady of Peace I have a little plaque that says “enjoy the journey”. As one of my favorite song says, “life is a journey” When people ask me I tell them that I am “journeying with cancer”. Put them together and I am reminded that I am to enjoy my life even with cancer.

I admit that “my” cancer does give some definition to my life. People who know my situation might say that having cancer limits me. In the day to day stuff of life it most certainly does limit me. But cancer, though it sets real physical boundaries for me, I have denied it the ability to define or to set limits to my spiritual life. My own personal sin may harm my relationship with the Blessed Trinity, but cancer does not define or weaken my love of God.

One of my favorite contemporary Christian songs is “Through It All” by Colton Dixon. A part of it says:

*I have won and I have lost
I've got it right sometimes
But sometimes I did not
Life's been a journey
I've seen joy, I've seen regret
Oh, and You have been my God
Through it all.*

Have you asked Father Paulin to join you in a summer adventure yet? The first week he was here I took him to Peru for a funeral and introduced him to our Bishop, Daniel Jenky, C.S.C. He also got to know Father Jim Ramer who travelled with us to the funeral. 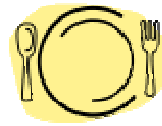

- Sit toward the front where it's easier to see and hear. Quietly explain the parts of the Mass.
- Sing the songs, pray and say the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.
- Feel free to leave Mass with your children if you need to, but please come back!

The way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the church, to God and to Jesus. Let them know that they are at home in this liturgical gathering.
