Adoration Reparation Thanksgiving Supplication
Traditionally these 4 types of prayer can round out our prayer life more fully.

1. Adoration: Begin your time in Adoration acknowledging God is God. Listed are just some of the ways that can be done. With a formal prayer, your own wordstelling God 'He is Lord of your life', singing, a simple invocation- 'My God and My All', or gaze upon our Lord with love.
2. Reparation: Examine your conscience-ask God for help in areas of temptation. Tell God how sorry you are for your failure/sin. Offer a prayer or devotion in reparation for your offences against God's love, and for sins of the whole world. Beg God's mercy. The Divine Mercy Chaplet can be prayed.
3. Thanksgiving: Think of all that you have and give thanks to God. It can be a litany for prayers answered or graces received such as life itself, our 5 senses, good earth, our Catholic faith, the sacraments, protection of our guardian angel, Jesus, Redemption, Blessed Mary, and the saints. The list is endless and unique to you.
4. Petition: the most common form of prayer. Be humble, with simple and direct words; ask for your need, prayer request for the intention of others, or whatever is on your heart. Just as Blessed Mary said to Jesus at the Wedding Feast of Cana, "They have no wine (Jn 2:3). Leave your petition with Jesus, to be accomplished according to His most holy will.
