GALA NEWS

The time is fast approaching for the 1st of 2 Early Bird Breakfasts. Dine with your Parish family after 8:30 A.M. Mass on July 14 as the The Gala Committee prepares a nice breakfast for you and announces the 1st Early Bird Winner. Could it be you? Get your raffle forms in soon. We look forward to seeing you.

Did you know that volunteering to be on one of the Gala committees does not prevent you from enjoying the evening with family and friends? (See the following Committee Descriptions). Even if you cannot be present for the Gala this year, know that volunteering, prior to the Gala, is very much appreciated!

Early Bird Breakfast Committee volunteers are done prior to the Gala, following the 2nd Early Bird Breakfast on August 11.

Live & Silent Auction Committee volunteers will approach businesses in person, over the phone, by email or a business' website (their is typically a donation request heading to select, followed by a form, instructions, or their policy on donation requests) prior to the Gala. Acceptable donations can be in the form of a raffle ticket purchase, cash, gift basket, sponsor basket, merchandise, a service (ex. a load of mulch or tree donation from a landscaper, a large equipment rental, etc), or an experience. Don't forget to contact your employer, if applicable. (Letters and raffle ticket forms to be given to business contacts are available through Darlene in the church office).

Gala Decorating Committee volunteers will set up dining tables with tables covers, table runners, plastic silverware, napkins and a centerpiece. Raffle basket, beverage and food tables will be covered with table cloths. Chinese paper lanterns will need to be assembled and hung above each table. There will also be an umbrella wall erected. This committees' responsibility is completed the evening before the Gala.

The responsibility of the Gala Greeters Committee is to simply greet the guests and welcome them to the Gala after the Saturday evening Mass and prior to the commencement of dinner.

The Gala Meal Prep Committee prepares drinks, a dessert and serves a restaurant prepared meal from chafing dishes.

The Gala Clean-Up Committee places coffee cups in the dishwasher, cleans drink containers and chafing dishes, wipes off tables and take the trash out at the conclusion of the Gala. (Plastic dinnerware allows for quick clean-up).

The Gala Check-Out Committee person assists the auctioneer and Darlene process customer purchases at the conclusion of the evening. (Only need 1 more person)
